Each school year, SWEPE hosts our Sustainability Clubs involving thousands of students across the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District. Sustainability Club programming invites students to become active members of their school and greater community to work towards conserving water, eliminating/reducing waste, and using energy efficiently.
